

## YDD REQUIREMENTS - Youthful (Under 25 Yrs) Drunk Driving Program

You must complete the YDD requirements within **120 days** and appear on the review date in 120 days with proof of completion:

\$175 1. Complete the DUI assessment and start the requirements in the assessment. The court requires the assessment *FIRST*.

\$100 2. Complete the YDD program successfully. Call Judy Phillips at **588-8433** *immediately* after court to schedule the initial appearance. It takes the entire 120 days to complete the program so **do not wait** to schedule the initial orientation. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO COMPLETE PROGRAM and so be on time for the scheduled appointments and if late you get no credit. You are required to pay \$100 dollars for this program and each time to reschedule is \$25 dollars.

\$150 OR [\$325 if 2nd or Assessor Rec's] 3. Complete the **DUI School**.

\$100 4. By the date of the review in 120 days, you must pay **\$50 dollars to the Court Fund** and **\$50 dollars to the VCA** at the criminal court clerk on the 2nd floor.

5. Go to the 2nd floor of the court house at the Cost Administrator Desk to set up payments immediately after court on the day you plea.

6. Appear on your review date in 120 days at **1:30 p.m.** in Court Room 173 with proof of completion of the requirements. A warrant may issue if you fail to appear.

\$710 + \$240 7. If you are successful, then you will be on a **6 month** deferred sentence and you will owe court costs of about \$710 dollars plus anything owed for additional counts or assessments if you had any. The money must be paid within the 6 month period of time or you will not get your case *dismissed and expunged*. The District Attorney charges a fee for supervision during the 6 month deferred sentence of \$40 dollars per month for **six (6) months** which is (\$240). If you are successful and you appear on the review date in 6 months then your **plea is expunged** and the **case dismissed without a conviction on your record**.

8. If on the *120 day review date* previously stated you are not successful then the prosecutor is recommending **7 days in jail** and then released to complete the YDD program requirements.

9. If on the *2nd time* you are not successful, then you will have a DUI conviction and 1 year suspended and \$750 fine, \$125 VCA, \$125 CF, plus court costs.

What is the "typical" (arguably there is **no typical case** because each case is different and may have certain defenses that require motion hearings and/or jury trials or hearings) flow chart of a Misdemeanor DUI Case for a person *under the age of 25 years* in Tulsa County:

1st appearance is the arraignment and usually is *passed for 30 days* for the defendant to hire a lawyer.

2nd appearance *may be passed* or may conduct the arraignment.

3rd appearance - defendant enters not guilty plea and the case is set for a conference in about 30 days.

Defendant is supposed to have an ASSESSMENT completed which costs (\$175) By NEXT APPEARANCE.

4th appearance - conference - defendant's attorney confers with the prosecutor and a plea bargain is usually agreed upon. Sometimes case is continued for defendant to get the assessment completed.

5th appearance - defendant enters a plea bargain and court orders defendant to complete the **all** YDD Requirements and passes sentencing for 120 days for the defendant to complete **ALL** of the YDD Requirements.

6th appearance - 120 day review date to see if defendant completed the YDD requirements and if successful then the defendant is given a 6 month deferred sentence from this date for *next 6 months*. If Not = Problem.

7th appearance - 6 month review date for deferred sentence. If Defendant is successful then case is DISMISSED and entry of plea is EXPUNGED.
